

FINANCIAL GOVERNANCE IN AFRICA IN THE DIGITAL ERA: CHALLENGES, CONSTRAINTS AND PROSPECTS

15 & 16 November 2023

Faced with the increasing crises in recent years (economic, health and financial), the economic world has been constantly wondering about strategic solutions to overcome them. Indeed, the management best practices offer an array of approaches and models that hammer on keywords such as flexibility, resilience, demarcation and value creation. In such a context, the issue of financial governance has become an acute theme.

In the meantime, the significant growth of digitalization, which is essentially based on the principle of innovation combined with numerical transformation, has prompted the development of various reflections on the theoretical foundations and key factors that influence the new development paradigm of companies and States.

Financial governance, like the digitalization of activities, faces a turbulent and constantly changing environment, characterized by increasing competition, rapid development of technologies and risks and uncertainties. This requires effective change speed that involve regular adjustments through innovative policies and strategies adapted to this new context.

Moreover, the African continent is no exception. We are witnessing hybrid realities with regard to financial governance within different organizations, companies and institutions. According to the African Development Bank¹, African countries have implemented a plan to redress socio-economic situation in their states through strategies and action plans geared towards financial governance.

Nevertheless, the leaders of African countries have been invited to proceed first to reforms; primarily those pertaining to financial governance. Accordingly, several recommendations have been made for the socio-economic development of African countries whether in the public sector, private sector, academia, and in the social and solidarity economy organizations.

The 2023 edition of the CIRMO 7 conference organized by the LAREMO research laboratory of the EST in Casablanca is expected to provide a precise diagnosis of this context. Under an African dimension, the comparative reflections, the crossed views on financial governance, its content, its contributions, the lived experiences, the illustrated cases, the implemented
